



## Calling Religious Youth!

### Participate in the *Religions for Peace* North American Young Adults Retreat 15-17 April 2011 | New York

*Religions for Peace* is currently calling for **vibrant and active** North American religious young adults to participate in a three-day retreat, to be held in Stony Point, New York, April 15-17, 2011. Eligible candidates should be between the ages of 18-35, and represent a religious community or organization.

The retreat will equip participants with the skills and knowledge to advance multi-religious cooperation for peace in the North American context. It will also address how religious youth can help shape the *Religions for Peace* Arms Down! Campaign ([www.armsdown.net](http://www.armsdown.net)) and advocate for disarmament in both the United States and Canada.

Individuals and organizations participating in the retreat will have the opportunity to be members of the North American Interfaith Youth Network and to contribute to the youth participation in the projected 2012 IX<sup>th</sup> World Assembly of *Religions for Peace*.
